SIZE 3 OFF 175,000 LITRE TANKS

Three 175m³ fibreglass tanks were supplied to the Edendale Dairy Company in the early 1990's. These three tanks were the first large fibreglass storage tanks supplied to the Dairy Industry.

These tanks are used to store the waste whey product. The tanks are fully piped up for the aggressive CIP cleaning. Since the photo was taken, a fourth GRP Tank has been added to the group.

Maskell have since completed the supply of number of 200,000 Litre storage tanks for the New Zealand South Island Dairy Industry. The 4.5mtanks were shifted to their destinations using coastal shipping and local freighter experienced in tank transport.

Once on site the tanks were installed on concrete foundations in accordance with New Zealand earthquake codes.
